## Navigating the Password-Protected Workspace

The **password-protected** website workspace provides registration access for an R-SCAN project. Participants with CareSelect imaging/ACR Select clinical decision support (CDS) platform, also can view their CDS Data Reports. Following is information about navigating the workspace. An ACR login is required to access and can be [created for free](#).

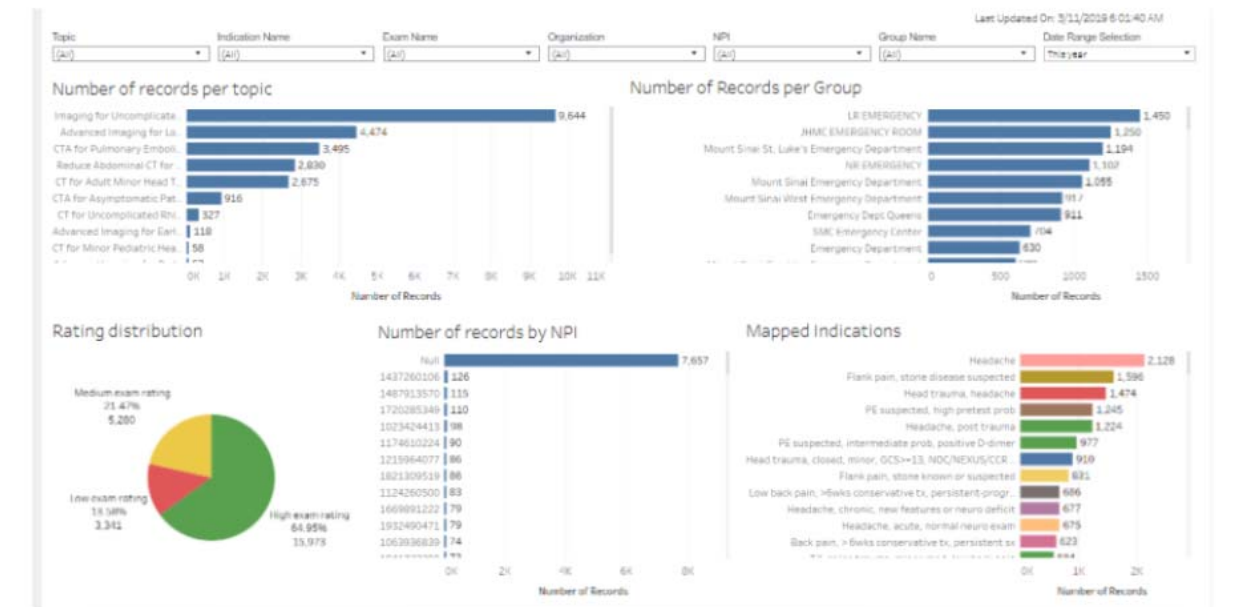
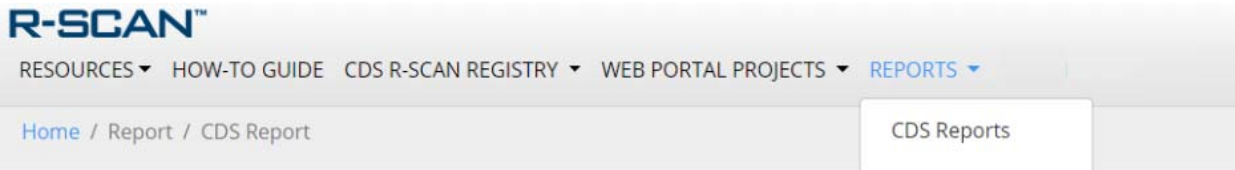
**Login to the Workspace:** From the R-SCAN home page, click “Start Your Project” or “Log in to Workspace.”

# Using the CDS R-SCAN Registry Data

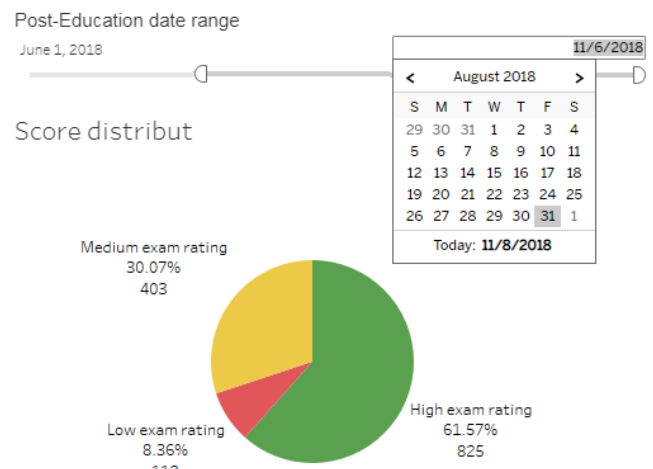
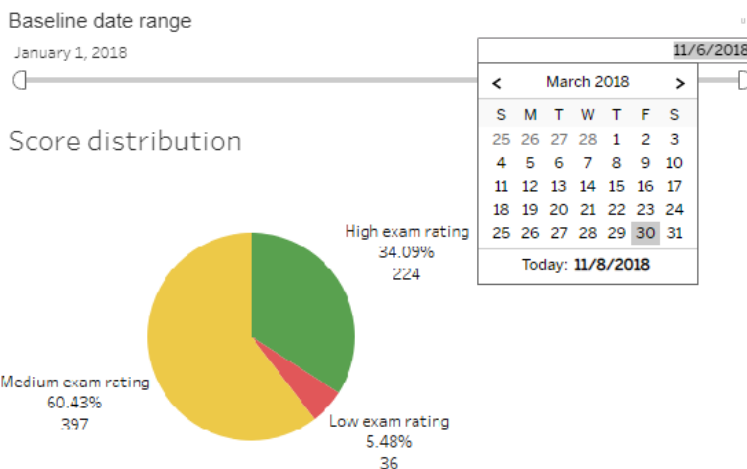
1. Select "Reports" and "CDS Reports" to view your facility's CDS data and, using the filters, select your topic parameters: Topic, Exams, Collaborating Group, Date Range.



2. Use the report to choose your baseline date range and, after the educational intervention, the post-education date range.

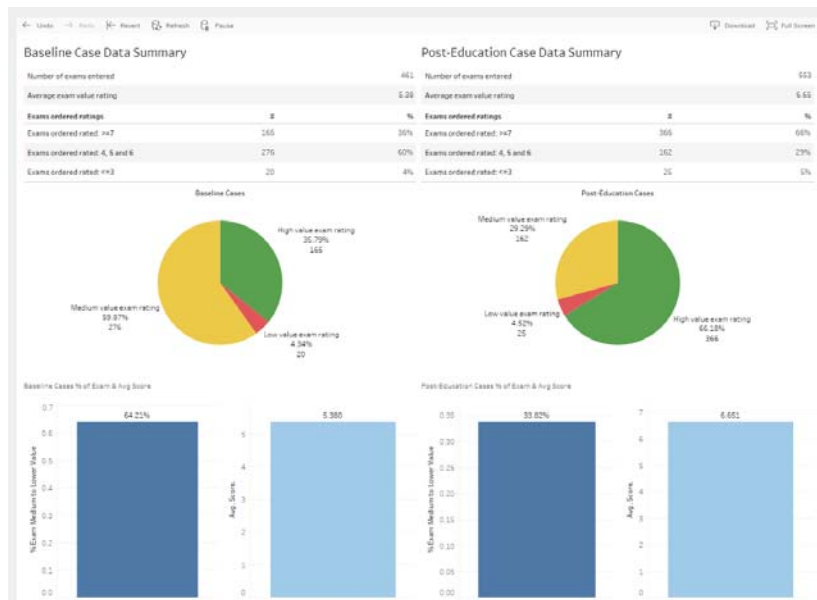


