Tips for Navigating the Public Website Section

The R-SCAN website has both a **public section** that anyone can access and a **password-protected section**. The latter requires sign in with an ACR username and password. Following are suggestions for what to review in the **public section** to help you get started.

1. Check out the **How-to Guide** for step-by-step description of engaging in an R-SCAN collaboration.
2. Click **CW Topics** to access the list of R-SCAN Choosing Wisely® topics.
3. See the **Learn More** page for a list of frequently asked questions and R-SCAN news and results.
4. Select the **Resources** button to access educational materials to include General Resources about practice transformation or “Topic-Specific Resources” for each of the R-SCAN Choosing Wisely topics.

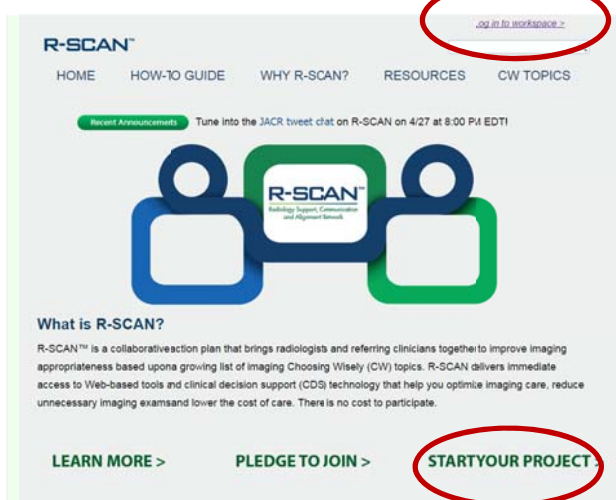


Tips for Navigating the Password-Protected Workspace

The **password-protected Workspace** provides access to the ACR Select clinical decision support (CDS) Web portal, free CME resources, the R-SCAN topic registration page, and the case data entry and reporting tool. Following are suggestions for navigating the R-SCAN Workspace.

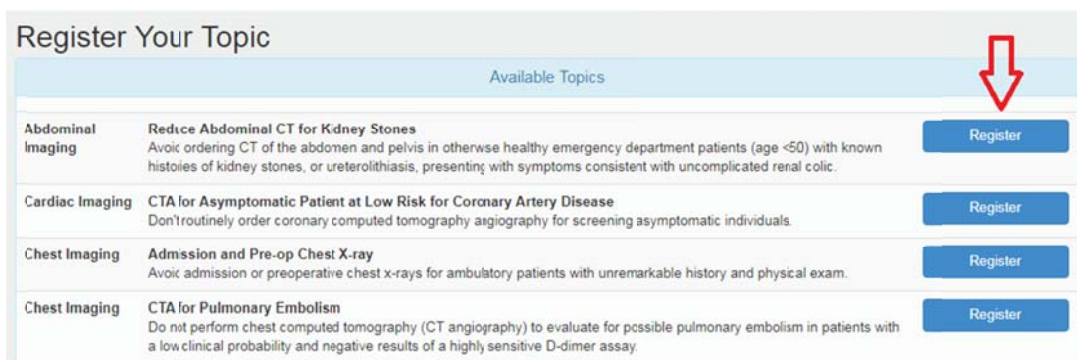
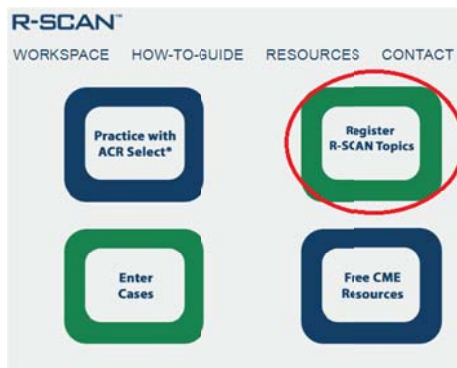
1. From the R-SCAN home page, click “Start Your Project” or “Log into Workspace.”

Next, log in to the password-protected Workspace using your ACR username and password.



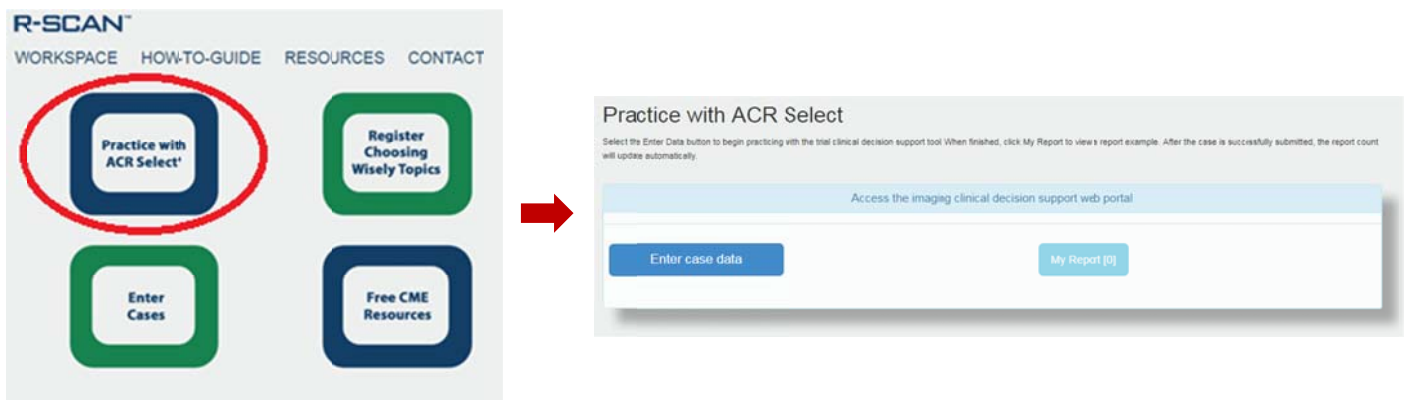
2. Register for a Topic

Click the “Register R-SCAN Topics” button to access the registration page. Select the “Register” button that corresponds with your R-SCAN topic and, when you’re ready to begin, complete the registration form.



3. Practice with ACR Select.

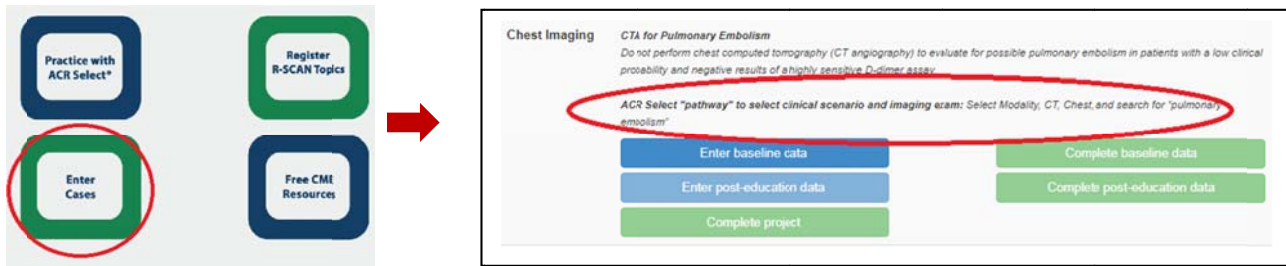
Click the “Practice with ACR Select” button to access the ACR Select Web portal. (See separate instructions for navigating the ACR Select Web portal.)



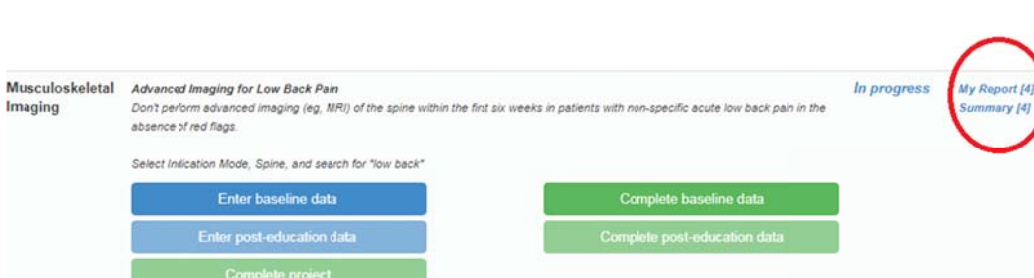
4. Enter Cases and Review Reports

In a clinical setting, ACR Select is used to support ordering the most appropriate imaging exam. In R-SCAN, ACR Select is used to rate the value of cases ordered retrospectively at baseline and after an educational collaboration. The case data you enter resides in the R-SCAN database and can be viewed only by the clinicians who have agreed to participate in a specific R-SCAN project.

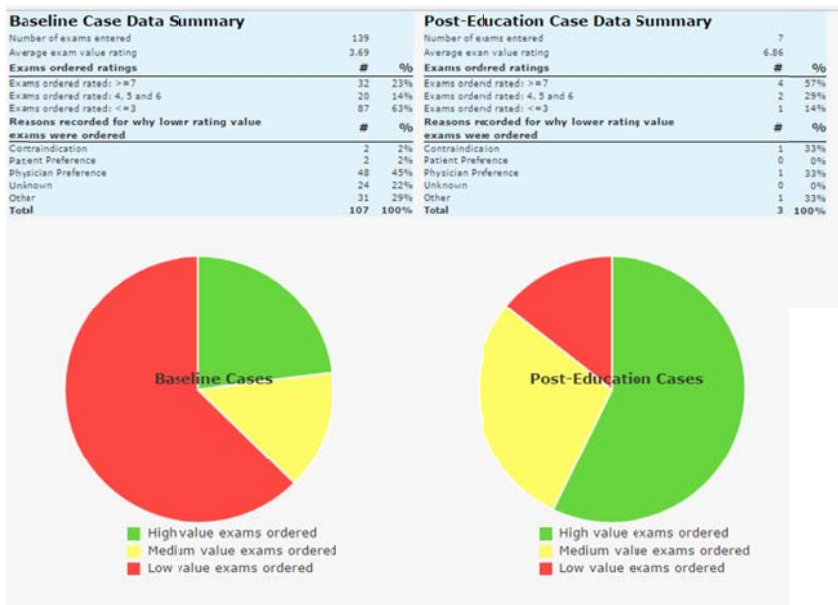
Upon registering an R-SCAN Choosing Wisely topic, click the “Enter Cases” button to access your registration. Review the pathway for entering data and click the “Enter baseline data” button to begin using ACR Select to rate your baseline cases.



Click “My Report” to view a case list and data summary of the cases you have entered. Click “Summary” to view a complete report if multiple persons are entering data for the same practice and Choosing Wisely topic.

5. Access Free CME

The ACR offers a collection of educational resources about general practice transformation and resources pertaining to each of the R-SCAN Choosing Wisely topics.

Click “Free CME Resources” for easy access to R-SCAN resources for which free CME are available. The resource collections are continuously being updated, so check back for new offerings.
